SUNDAY REFLECTIONS CONNECTION

“Be of one heart and one mind. Share everything in common!” What kind of a world is that? How is this way of life even possible?



Through everything he did and taught, Jesus believed in this way of life. He never wavered from his mission to proclaim that the reign of God was possible and to call disciples to preach that message to all the ends of the earth.

We begin to hear the hints of Pentecost in this Sunday's readings. In 1 John, the Spirit is truth. In John's Gospel, the Spirit comes upon them as breath. And in the Acts reading, we see the fruits of the Spirit in the way that the community members treat one another.

INCLUDING YOUTH

Luke's “Everything was just absolutely peachy” description of the Christian community can invite several cynical responses. “Obviously it has gone downhill since then,” or “Good for them; but I don't see that around here.” If someone asked you to describe your family or a team you are on, you might list positive things like helping each other; being there for one another and generally being good with each other; those are the really important things overall. You might gloss over or skip saying anything about occasional loud arguments, slammed doors and letting each other down. Luke may have been doing something similar in his portrayal of his utopian community.

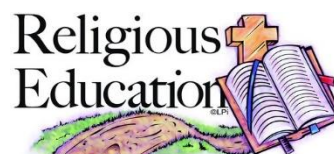
