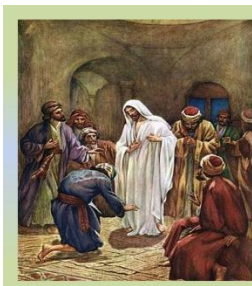

SET YOUR FAITH ON FIRE

+ It sparks my faith to know there are politicians who resist the temptation to lie about something that displeases their constituents -- that they understand that lying is not acceptable to us.

+ People who are persecuted for their faith are an inspiration to me, to keep my faith on fire.

+ A person who helped me set my faith on fire was a woman I knew 40 years ago who really lived the Lenten season and was ecstatic when Easter came, as though it were the first Easter she had ever experienced.

SUNDAY REFLECTIONS CONNECTION

Psalm 4, proclaimed this Sunday, assured us and all who will listen that God hears our prayer: "The Lord will hear me when I call upon him." It offers images of peaceful sleep and security within the care of God, simply by having God's face shine upon us: "Why are you troubled?"



In the midst of their struggles and doubts, the disciples simply had to see the Lord's face and hear his words of peace. He asks them, "Why are you troubled? And why do questions arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet, that it is I myself."

Do we call out? Do we see? Do we recognize God's peace when we see it? When we do, the risen Lord invites us to live as witnesses to the world.

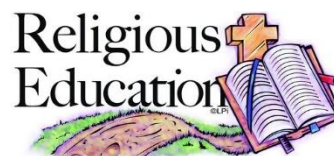
