"Bringing and Living Faith, Hope and Love in the Home."

1. **Extend your Prayer Life:** throughout the day and together as family when possible.
2. **Remember the Dead:** Share your Family History, the stories and identity. Honor the dead and pray for them. It makes death normal.
3. **Admit your Mistakes:** Know that you do not have to be perfect. You are not unique in your sins.
4. **Manual Labor:** It provides a sense of contribution and ownership in the family and elsewhere. It causes us to feel and be part of the family.
5. **Technology:** In the past technology gave us more time to do important things especially in and for the family. Today technology eats

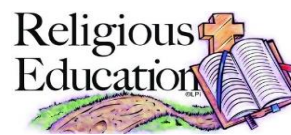
