**CONNECTIONS**

In past years, California evening skies were illuminated by an unearthly great light. Viewers may have wondered if it was the second coming. The sun painted the clouds silver and gold and could be seen from San Francisco to Mexico. The light was caused by a rocket launch from Vandenberg Air Base near Santa Barbara.

Seeing the unearthly vision of the resurrected Christ must have been terrifying for the fishermen in the Gospel. It challenged their faith just as it does ours. One day, each of us, perhaps at death, will see an unearthly light in our skies. When that day comes, remember Jesus' closing words in the Gospel: "Follow Me."

**INCLUDING YOUTH**

Few young people will be told not to preach in the name of Jesus. But they will be told not to act as a follower of Jesus. It will not come as a direct command from a person in authority, but indirectly, perhaps not even spoken. It may come more as a silent insinuation that religion is for the emotionally and socially lame. However, being a part of the victory celebration depicted in Revelation – it is worth making certain we do not throw that away.

As we hear in John's Gospel, the risen Lord of all creation appears to his friends on a lakeshore. Having prepared a charcoal fire and fish and bread, Jesus says, "Come, have breakfast." How cool is that!

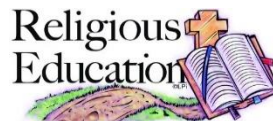
