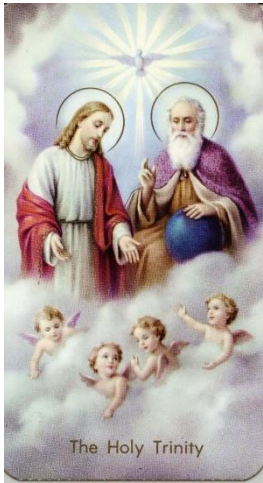

SUNDAY REFLECTIONS CONNECTION

All during the Easter season we have heard assurances of Jesus' continued presence among us.



Today's Gospel continues that pattern. After commissioning the doubting disciples, Jesus says, "I am with you always."

If Jesus were speaking to us today, he might say, "I've got your back" or "You can count on me." It is the very essence of covenant fidelity that describes our God. It is our task to make sure that it also describes us as faith communities.

Who in our town, city or neighborhood needs to hear from us these assuring words, "We've got your back"?

INCLUDING YOUTH

An image of the Trinity; three people, connected by arms around each other's waist, begin spinning, reaching 800 rpm (the average speed of a washer's spin cycle). One would observe simply a blur. Inside it, however, are three distinct people, becoming, in a sense, one by intense spinning. The Trinity are "Three in One" not through intense spinning, but infinite love.



Again, one line in the Ascension scene is startling: "When they all saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted." Doubt in spite of seeing. Youth often worship, at least in the sense of praying, yet doubt things associated with the faith.



SET YOUR FAITH ON FIRE

...Who has helped me set my Faith on fire? A person who came from another Faith tradition, for whom it took courage to embrace Catholicism, and whose family then more or less disowned him.

PLC'S Parish Life Coordinators will meet with Archbishop Thompson over lunch on this Wednesday, May 30.

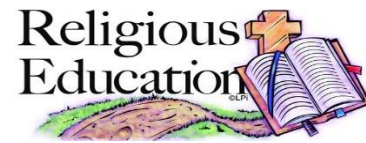
