SUNDAY REFLECTIONS CONNECTIONS

In the movie "An Officer and a Gentleman," Richard Gere portrays a Navy officer training candidate. In a scene, when he is close to breaking the record for negotiating the obstacle course, he goes back to help Casey, a female officer candidate who had been unable to climb the 12-foot wall. Sacrificing his own chance to set a record, he helped her climb the mandatory wall, thus assuring she would graduate as an Ensign. By helping her, he proved himself worthy – as leader and had truly become an officer and a gentleman.

INCLUDING YOUTH

The longer version of the Gospel convincingly illustrates that the apostles were not protected by their initial call from outright, comical childishness. One approach might be to make a point of this and, as the assembly is seemingly amused, ask a blunt question, "How often have you done this – considered yourself important (above others) and hence worthy of reward?"



The shorter version, besides being excellent reading for all those in civil or ecclesial office, invites everyone including youth to consider how they behave toward those whom they are, at least temporarily at times, in charge of. Younger siblings or cousins are an excellent example.

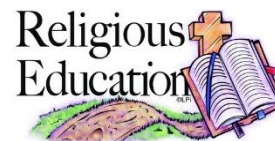
faith formation and Catholic Education and 54% for seminarian education and clergy care for our 48 retired priests who have devoted their lives to serving others.
