The annual Relay for Life has been moved to August this year. The event was cancelled last year and this year, the St. John's team will join Dearborn/Ohio Counties for their drive-thru event. In lieu of a bake sale this year, the ladies agreed to make a donation to this cause.

In closing, it was determined the ladies would meet again the second Tuesday in June and Rosie would revise and distribute a new calendar to each member. That meeting will begin at 5:30. Rosie then closed with the "Prayer to St. Anne".
