Jill requested the Ladies' Society be willing to cover the cost of the main course. Janice made a motion to approve and Mary Ann seconded. Parishioners will be asked to bring an appetizer or a side dish and will be able sign up a couple weeks beforehand.

Activities for that day will include euchre, cornhole, pickleball and a bounce house. Sharon will create invites promoting the event.

- Planning for the Fall **Rummage Sale**, October 3-5: Sorting will begin the week of September 29. The hours for the sale will be 8 am - 5pm on Thursday & Friday; Saturday's hours will be 8am-noon.
- Planning for a **Craft Fair**: Vickie suggested we plan to host a craft fair if we could coordinate such an event in October or November. This can be discussed again at the next meeting.
