Jessica will bring onions & cheese; Jill will provide crackers and ice; drinks such as coffee, water and lemonade will be provided.

Finally, there was discussion about the posting of meeting minutes, an invitation to all women of the parish to join our group, and the reorganizing of the funeral dinner list. Sharon has already posted minutes from last year's meetings on the parish website; she will also include a special invite to all women of the parish to join in our chili supper in March. A revision of the funeral dinner list has been requested and will be addressed at our next meeting.
