In new business, the Rummage Sale is planned for October 6, 7 and 8 with hours on Thursday and Friday from 8 am - 6 pm and Saturday from 8 am - 12 pm. Volunteers are needed to set up and work.

Jill offered that Father Binu will be celebrating his Jubilee, 25 years as a priest. All were encouraged to save the date for May 7, 2023 as there will be a special Sunday evening Mass and dinner on that day.

Mary Ann and Jill will be decorating the parish hall this November to prepare for the Ladies' Christmas Party. Decorating will take place on Sunday, November 27, from 1-3 pm.

The Ladies' Christmas Party was scheduled for the first Sunday in December, December 4 beginning at 1 pm. Rosie will set up a caterer, there will be a \$5 gift exchange and entertainment will be planned.

Rosie then concluded the meeting with a closing prayer. A motion was made by Sharon and seconded by Mary Ann to adjourn the meeting.
