*Speak, for Your
servant is listening.*

1 Samuel 3:10

CONNECTIONS

Just as he did when he came in dreams to Samuel, God reveals himself to us and offers an invitation to follow Him. Our response allows God to bless us with his great power and so the kingdom may advance.

Today the voice of God comes to each one of us, inviting us to respond with the words of Samuel, "Speak, for your servant is listening."

When there is no reply, or a "busy" signal, God will come again. God's patience is infinite.

INCLUDING YOUTH – The delightful story from First Samuel illustrates that, following Eli's example, we should be open to the ways in which God may be calling our youth. They are the church of tomorrow. What a tragedy if they become permanently alienated today.



An acknowledgement within the homily of their importance can help prevent that.

Paul's point in today's passage from First Corinthians: The body is holy. What we do with it can be anywhere from holy to selfish and unhealthy. We know what much of our culture promotes. Do not listen.

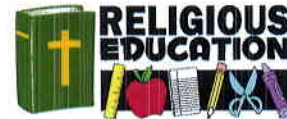

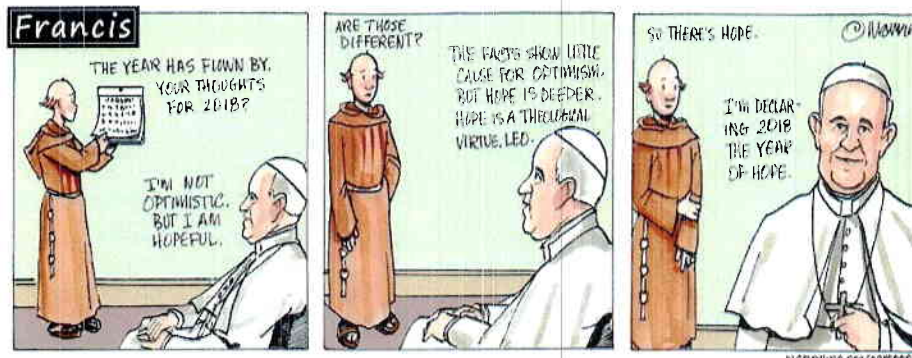
